

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, NETHERBURY

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along VARIOUS ROADS, NETHERBURY;

CROOK HILL from 20 April 2026 until 28 April 2026.
DRURY LANE from 29 April 2026 until 01 May 2026.
BRIDGE STREET and CHANTRY STREET from 05 May 2026 until 08 May 2026.
TOWER HILL from 05 May 2026 until 15 May 2026.
WHITECROSS from 11 May 2026 until 15 May 2026.
ST JAMES ROAD from 18 May 2026 until 22 May 2026.

The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 20 April 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 22 May 2026.

This Order will enable Wessex Internet, to carry out installation of ducting and fibre cable.
