

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT NOTICE, C18, DOTTERY

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 03 September 2026 and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 04 September 2026.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway resurfacing works.

The effect of this Notice is as follows:

- [1] To impose a temporary road closure on C18, DOTTERY between The Hermitage and a point approximately 470 metres south east.
- [2] To impose a parking suspension, as indicated by signs on site, to prevent parking on the highway along C18, DOTTERY between The Hermitage and a point approximately 470 metres south east.
- [3] To impose a clearway, as indicated by signs on site, to prevent waiting on the highway along C18, DOTTERY between The Hermitage and a point approximately 470 metres south east.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
