

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C96, SOUTH BOWOOD

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along C96, SOUTH BOWOOD between its junction with B3162 and Emmanuels Cross, a distance of 1215 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 17 August 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 August 2026.

This Order will enable Wessex Internet to carry out fibre cable installation and splicing.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Bridge Street - Drury Lane - A3066 - Pymore Lane - B3162
