

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PINEAPPLE LANE, SALWAY ASH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along PINEAPPLE LANE, SALWAY ASH between Ash Lane and a point approximately 180 metres north. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 21 April 2026 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 23 April 2026.

This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to replace poles.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: C96 - Ash Lane
