

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, SALWAY ASH

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along VARIOUS ROADS, SALWAY ASH;

PITCHERS, SALWAY ASH in its entirety. These works are programmed to commence from 08 June 2026 until 12 June 2026.

PINEAPPLE LANE, SALWAY ASH between its junction with B3162 and a point approximately 565 metres south east. These works are programmed to commence from 22 June 2026 until 26 June 2026.

The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 08 June 2026 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26 June 2026.

### **This Order will enable Wessex Internet to carry out fibre cable installation.**

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows; Ash Lane - C96 - Pymore Lane - B3162
